

Prior to your intake appointment you are required to complete the following steps:

- 1). Take the TABE Test after you have been called in for an Intake Appointment. If you do not have a four year college degree, you are required to take the TABE TEST which is provided on Mondays, at 10:30am 12:30pm. After you have completed the TABE TEST you will be given an *Eligibility Review Appointment*
- 2). If you have a "FOUR YEAR COLLEGE DEGREE", GRANTED OR AWARDED, you must provide a copy of your degree or transcripts. If you are unable to provide this documentation, please take the TABE test
- 3). Complete the online Customer Survey Form in the Resource Room after the orientation presentation
- 4). Open an Illinois workNet account at <a href="www.illinoisworknet.com">www.illinoisworknet.com</a>, Register with Illinois Skills Match and print out a copy of your profile (<a href="http://illinoisskillsmatch.com">http://illinoisskillsmatch.com</a>).
- 5). Bring your updated resume
